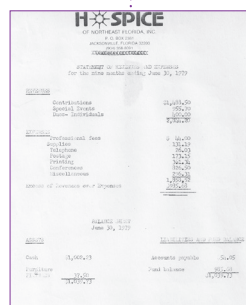
Honoring Choices Florida, an initiative of Community Hospice, brings together leaders from major health care organizations in order to establish advance care planning for the community-at-large.
