



We are making changes to the visitation guidelines at our Earl B. Hadlow, Bailey Family, and Anne and Donald McGraw Centers for Caring as part of the Stage One Recovery plan. We are currently not allowing visitors to the Dr. Gaston J. Acosta-Rua Center for Caring. Please take a moment to review these guidelines.

There is signage posted at the entrance to our facilities outlining these visitation guidelines:

- All visitors will continue to be screened.
- Visitation is now limited to 2 people at a time per patient and is limited to the patient's room.
- No children under the age of 12 are allowed unless they are a patient.
- Video/teleconference is available at all locations.
- No pets are allowed.
- We will provide visitors with reusable masks, which must be worn during visitation.
- We have closed our gathering areas, including our family rooms, quiet rooms, public restrooms, porches, and chapels.
- We will continue to accommodate families whose loved one is in the dying process.
